More in Common

I attended the 37th Tres Dias International Assembly with my husband, Paul, along with Tom Miller July 15-17 near Newburgh, NY where Tres Dias originated in 1972. We were hosted by the Mid-Hudson Tres Dias community, now holding their 150+ sets of weekends.

Community directors were given a private time for meeting informally with the outgoing President of Tres Dias (Bruce Cato) and the incoming President (Frank Yarbrough) on Friday evening.

I thought you would be interested in hearing about what other chapters of Tres Dias are experiencing in their respective communities:

- Slim attendance at Secuelas (engagement)
- Pescadores not plugging into Reunion Groups (engagement and sponsorship)
- Accommodating more candidates on weekends (sponsorship)
- Finances (cost of the weekend and fee gap)

ALTD has the same issues and concerns that large and small Tres Dias communities are experiencing, but in this newsletter I will focus on finances.

Some of the ways your Secretariat is addressing these financial concerns include:

 Go Fund Me – available on the ALTD website, we've already received donations of two laptop computers, paper products, and several cash donations

- Stateline Pizza Wars (Elkhorn and Roscoe Pizza Ranch locations) generated \$800 in one night – but we can't do it without volunteers and ALTD ambassadors helping
- Love Offerings taken at Closings and Secuelas will benefit the general fund for more flexibility to buy supplies and pay for weekend expenses not covered in the fee
- Soliciting charitable giving –
 ALTD received a \$3,000 grant
 recently from an anonymous
 source to help with weekend
 retreat expenses. The result of
 this charitable gift was due to
 being directly solicited by an
 ALTD community member thank you!
- We are saving on weekend costs at Inspiration Ministries by holding the spring weekends in March instead of May

Do you have ideas, thoughts, or suggestions on ways ALTD could keep the cost of the weekend reasonable for candidates and team? We would love to hear your ideas!
